**Paul’s relationship to the Corinthians**

- He ministered to Corinth for 1-½ years on his 2<sup>nd</sup> MJ
- Wrote a letter to Corinth (now lost – 1 Cor. 5:9, 11)
- On his third MJ he stayed at Ephesus for 2-1/2 years. A delegation from Corinth came with questions and concerns. He wrote I \_\_\_\_\_ in response
- Paul visited the Corinthians due to problems – a “\_\_\_\_\_ visit”
- Paul then wrote a “\_\_\_\_\_ letter” and sent it with Titus (2 Cor. 2:3-4; 7:8-9)
- No news from Titus made Paul go to Macedonia (2 Cor. 2:13; 7:5-6)  
There he found Titus and received news about the church. The news was primarily good, but there was still opposition from a few
- Paul wrote \_\_\_\_\_ in response
- Paul visited Corinth a third time (Acts 20:2-3)
