*A* good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold. (Prov. 22:1)


## God's name is to be on (1 Chron 16:8-10)

- *Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name;* make known among the nations what he has done.
  - 9 Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts.
  - <sup>10</sup> Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice.

<sup>7</sup> "You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
